President's Report, Jan Kane-

Vice President's Report, Andrea Delaney-

- Car wash was successful. The band made \$431. Thanks to all the volunteers!
- Coin wars start next week and are separated by section i.e. woodwinds, brass, percussion, guard. Coin wars will go on thru the 3rd week of band camp and amounts will be tallied daily. Metal money is considered a positive point and paper money is considered a negative point. A kid could throw a \$10 bill into someone's pot and that will be considered a negative point and bring their total down. This encourages the kids to compete against one another and raise more money by trying to bring the other team down by throwing in paper money.
